### STEWARDS' DECISION N°6

**From** The Stewards  
**To** Competitor and driver of car 9  
Race Director, Clerk of the Course, Timekeeping

The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director (document n°3), having examined CCTV evidence, summoned and heard driver and competitor, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

**Car N°, Driver and Competitor** : 9 – FRANCESCO BRASCHI – FA RACING

**Time of fact:** 09.30

**Session:** Qualifying 1 – Group A

**Facts:** The car was driven unnecessarily slowly, erratically or in a manner which could be deemed potentially dangerous to other drivers and which blocked other cars.

**Offence:** Breach of article 24.22 of the FRECA Sporting Regulations

**Decision:** NO FURTHER ACTION

**Reason:** Having considered the matter extensively, after reviewing video and on-board evidence, the stewards determined that:


the driver N° 9 was not wholly or predominantly to blame for allegedly driving unnecessarily slowly, erratically or in a manner which could be deemed potentially dangerous to other drivers or any other person. There are a number of cars that during the lap slow down, in line, out of the line and doing that all the cars were involved in the same situation. The drivers and the team manager agree this matter should be discuss in the next driver briefing for safety reason. All parties were relived that no contact was made.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 9.1.1 of the FIA Judicial and Disciplinary Rules, within the applicable time limits.


