BULLETIN 1 TO THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

From The Stewards
To Competitors and drivers
Race Director, Clerk of the Course, Timekeeping

1. Please note the following amendment to the supplementary regulations for this event:

PART A

4. Start time of the Races:

Race 1: Saturday (8/07/2023) ~~43h50~~ 13h51
Race 2: Sunday (9/07/2023) ~~46h20~~ 16h21

2. The following modifications to the Formula Regional by Alpine 2023 Sporting Regulations will only be applicable during the Mugello event scheduled on 07-09 July 2023:

31.1. ~~Fifteen (15)~~ Sixteen (16) minutes before the start of the formation lap, the pit exit will be opened and all cars, including any that are required to start the race from the pit lane, will be permitted to leave the pit lane to cover one or several reconnaissance laps. At the end of this lap all cars starting the race from the grid must stop on the grid in the starting order with their engines stopped.

Should any driver wish to cover more than one reconnaissance lap, this must be done by driving down the pit lane at greatly reduced speed between each of the laps. Any dangerous driving or any exceeding of the speed limits in the pit lane between reconnaissance laps will be sanctioned by a penalty against the offending driver pursuant to Article 24.10.

All drivers going to the pit exit at this time must do so at a constant speed and with a constant throttle. This applies over the whole of the pit lane whether a driver is going to the pit exit from his garage or his position in the pit lane, or travelling through the pit lane between reconnaissance laps.

Any car which does not complete a reconnaissance lap and can not reach the starting grid under its own power will not be permitted to start the race from the starting grid.

31.2. ~~Nine (9)~~ Ten (10) minutes before the start of the formation lap, a warning signal will be given indicating that the exit of the pit lane will be closed in two (2) minutes.


~~Seven (7)~~ Eight (8) minutes before the scheduled start of the formation lap the end of the pit lane will be closed and a second warning signal will be given. Any car which is still in the pit lane can start from the end of the pit lane, provided it got there under its own power. If more than one car is affected, they must line up in the order in which they qualified. However, any car reaching the end of the pit lane after the "five minutes" signal must start behind any other car already aligned at the pit exit.

All such cars may then join the race once the whole field has passed the end of the Pit Lane for the first time after the start.


