

### Article 1 - Preamble

Pirelli Tyre S.p.A- Motorsport, in cooperation with ACI Sport and Alpine Racing, announces, organizes and will award a prize, called the "**Racelienc Award**", reserved for drivers who will participate in the Formula Regional European Championship by Alpine 2024.

### Article 2 - Purpose of the Classification

The purpose of the classification drawn up based on the following articles is to reward the driver who, in each individual race and at the end of the championship, will have improved his or her position in the final ranking of the races concerning the position on the starting grid at the events valid for the Formula Regional European Championship by Alpine.

### Article 3 - Participating Drivers

All drivers who will take part in the races included in the calendar of the Formula Regional European Championship by Alpine 2024 independent of whether or not they acquire points for the final championship standings are eligible by right.

Registration is free of charge.

### Article 4 - Score Allocation

The allocation of points to each individual driver shall be determined based on the difference between their position on the final starting grid and their position in the final definitive race classification (Example: starting grid position 10th, finishing position 5th = acquired score of 5 points), taking into account the following:

- Negative scores are not considered (Example: starting grid position 5th, finishing position 10th = acquired score of 0 points).
- In the event of disqualification from the final definitive race classification due to sporting reasons or technical infringements, 10 points (-10) will be deducted from the final standings of the "Racelienc Award".
- Scores are also considered for withdrawing drivers. They will be assigned a position based on the information provided in the final race classifications regardless of whether they are classified or not.

### Article 5 - Rankings

Event (2 Races) and Championship Overall rankings will be compiled.

To be included in the Final Overall Ranking of the "Racelienc Award," drivers must have participated in at least 8 race events. At the end of the championship, those who have not reached the established minimum participation will be removed from the ranking.

The winner (Event and Overall) will be declared the driver who has accumulated the highest score in their respective rankings as indicated below:

Event: Race 1 + Race 2

Overall: Sum of all events they have participated in.

### Article 6 - Discriminants in the case of a tie

In the case of a tie for the top three, positions in the event and Championship standings will be assigned based on the following:

- The highest position will be assigned based on the highest first places in the event, in case of absence or ties, the second places will move on.
- In case of further ties, the greatest number of pole positions will be considered.
- In case of absence or ties the Rookie qualification will be considered.
- In case of further ties, the date of birth (youngest) will be taken into consideration.

### Article 7 - Awards

An honour award (Trophy) will be given to the first-place winner of the event rankings of the first 9 events. Individual event awards will be given at the next event and the place and time will be communicated to the Team Manager of the winning driver's team.

An Honor Award (Pirelli Wheel) will be given to the first-place winner of the overall "Racelienc Award" rankings.

The final "Racelienc Award" ceremony will be held in conjunction with the official awards ceremony of the Formula Regional European Championship by Alpine, which will take place at the end of the last event in Monza.
